



Officer Pretko retires after 25 years of service to Brandermill

Officer Rodney Pretko, a longtime friend to and protector of the Brandermill community, will retire from the Chesterfield County Police Force on September 1st. After 27 years of service, Pretko says he is looking forward to riding his motorcycle and fishing.

There have been many times where this father of five has counseled Brandermill youth, given a grieving family his comfort and kept residents informed of threats to the community.

One only has to Google his name to see a long list of accomplishments. In 2007, Pretko was awarded a gold Valor Award for his role in helping save children trapped inside of a burning home. A report of the event tells that “the heat was so great that it melted the soles of Officer Pretko’s boots.” A bear cub, found on Genito Road, was given a second chance at life after being rescued by Officer Pretko, who refused to follow orders to euthanize the cub. There are

countless other stories illustrating the generosity he has shown others, the lives he has changed and the bravery he has shown.

We are indeed grateful for his service to Chesterfield and to Brandermill.

What happens to my boat space when I move from Brandermill?

Here are 6 points to consider.

1. Residents moving out of Brandermill need to cancel their boat registrations and remove boats from assigned t-racks, the beachfront and the trailer parking lot at The Landing. Canceling a boat registration is as simple as calling the BCA or sending an email to Donna Allen at dallen@brandermill.com
2. T-rack assignments do not convey with the sale of a boat. Once the sale is made the resident needs to cancel his or her personal boat registration releasing the boat storage space back to the BCA.
3. New boat owners need to register kayaks, paddleboards, Jon boats, canoes, and pontoon boats by coming to the BCA. Your signature is needed to obtain a BCA registration sticker for each watercraft. This sticker indicates residency and the four digits match up with the resident registration at the Brandermill Community Association.
4. Residents displaying current boating registration stickers on their boats may use the boat launch at Sunday Park and The Landing.
5. Boats that do not display a current registration sticker or a readable BCA sticker cannot be identified and are removed by the BCA.
6. Boat owners neglecting to display current registration stickers are asked to remove their boat for non-compliance.
