What causes a solar eclipse? What does it look like? What can we observe during an eclipse? How often do they occur? How can we observe a solar eclipse safely? What is the difference between a partial eclipse and a total eclipse? Find the answers to these questions at The Great American Eclipse Program.

For the first time in 99 years, a total eclipse will cross the entire continental United States, hence the name "The Great American Eclipse". Dr. Henry Nebel, Professor of Physics at the University of

Richmond and Brandermill resident, will discuss the importance of the total eclipse of the sun on August 21st. Dr. Nebel will be our guide to understand, prepare for and view this beautiful celestial event.

In Richmond the eclipse will be partial only. Some slides will be shown indicating what the partial phases will look like. Safe viewing will be discussed, and viewing glasses will be passed out. If it is a sunny day, we will go outside and view the sun through safe viewing glasses.

## Wondering Why Your Brush Pile Wasn't Picked Up?

### Brush Pick-Up Guidelines and Taboos

Our residents diligently maintain their properties...especially their yards.. The primary reason the Brandermill Community Association instituted its Brush Collection Program in 2015 was to assist homeowners in beautifying Brandermill. Our original goal was to involve the membership in disposing of the deadfall, windblown sticks, and natural debris throughout the community.

However; there is an important distinction between "brush" and "yard waste". Listed below are the guidelines of our Brush Collection Program to help you determine whether to *Let It Stay* or *Take It Away*.

#### COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- ◆ Brush includes **ONLY "deadfall"** tree limbs and natural debris. Branches greater than 6 feet in length must be broken up. Leaves will NOT be collected.
- ◆ **ONE** pile per residential property. Crews will not collect multiple piles on one parcel. Remember, this is a MONTHLY collection—we will be back so there is no need to dispose of everything at one time.
- ◆ Crews will **NOT** collect "brush" resulting from resident or contractor tree removal and site preparation for fence installation or other structures, hedge or bush pruning, tree trimming, or lot clearing/landscaping debris. These cuttings and debris are the owner's responsibility. In many cases, the owner may need to hire a private contractor to remove these items from their property. Residents who do not dispose of debris within 7 days of placing curbside will be considered in violation and will be cited accordingly.

**Did you know....? Illegal dumping, also known as "midnight" dumping is the term used to describe disposing of waste in unauthorized areas. It is an environmental crime. Anyone convicted of a violation in the state of Virginia shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by confinement in jail for not more than 12 months and a fine of not less than \$250 or more than \$2,500, either or both. These unauthorized areas include community common space.**



## County Convenience Centers to offer expanded hours

Both Chesterfield County convenience centers will offer expanded hours starting July 31.

The Northern Area Convenience Center, at 3200 Warbro Road in Midlothian, will now be open Saturday, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday and Friday from 7 a.m.-6 p.m. The Southern Area Convenience Center, at 6700 Landfill Drive in Chester, will be open Saturday, Sunday, Monday, Thursday and Friday from 7 a.m.-6 p.m. Mulch will be loaded at the Southern Area location from 8 a.m.-noon on Thursdays, except in rainy or wet conditions.

Rates will not change. The expansion of hours is in response to a citizen survey conducted by the county's Department of General Services.

"The expansion of hours will help our customers get in and out of the convenience centers more quickly and safely," said Jeff Howard, environmental manager. "Opening the centers two and a half hours earlier each morning is a cost-effective way to serve the community."
