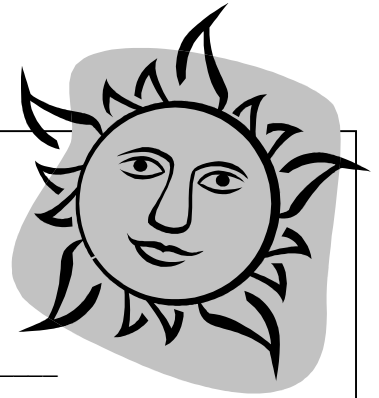

## A Pool Party Request form must be completed for:

- ◆ Any party with 10 or more guests. All minor birthday parties with 5 or more minor guests.
- ◆ A Pool Party request form can be obtained from the BCA office or downloaded from website. The Pool Party Request form must be turned into the head lifeguard at the pool you wish to hold the party **AT LEAST two (2) weeks in advance of the party.** (First come, First Serve basis).
- ◆ No more than 10 guests with guest passes may be admitted to a pool party.
- ◆ No more than 4 tables may be used during the 2 hour scheduled party time.
- ◆ Tables will not be reserved for pool parties.
- ◆ The pool party patrons are responsible for cleaning up all food/trash/spills on the tables and the pool deck where the party took place. (Ask a lifeguard for supplies)
- ◆ Only one (1) party will be scheduled at any given time. Party requests may be denied if another party is scheduled during that particular time.
- ◆ The pool manger reserves the right to deny a pool party admittance to the pool area if the party did not comply with the afore mentioned "Pool Party" rules.
